The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking directions to the official respondents to conduct free and impartial investigation in case FIR No. 218 dated 10.10.2016, registered under Sections 323, 354, 506 and 34 of the IPC at Women Police Station, Gurgaon.

Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent-State submits that during the pendency of this petition, investigation was carried out by SI Raj Bala, Women Police Station, Gurgaon and all the five accused were granted interim bail by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Gurgaon on 02.11.2016 and thereafter they joined investigation on 21.11.2016. The statement of the prosecutrix has already been recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. and the accused persons have been granted regular bail by an order dated 06.10.2011.

In view of the fact that the investigation was carried out and the accused persons are on regular bail, no further orders are called for in the present case.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
