JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of cross case registered vide DDR No.40, dated 05.07.2015, under Sections 307/323/148/149 IPC and 25/27 Arms Act, 1959 in FIR No. 192, dated 04.07.2015, under Sections 307/452/324/506/447/511/427/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise.

2. In compliance of order dated January 20, 2016, report of Id. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran, has been received, in

which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise with their free will, consent, without any threat, coercion, undue influence, promise or pressure from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and Rapat No.40, dated 05.07.2015, under Sections 307/323/148/149 IPC and 25/27 Arms Act, 1959 in FIR No. 192, dated 04.07.2015, under Sections 307/452/324/506/447/511/ 427/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
