Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise all the pleas before the trial court at the appropriate stage. He, however, further submits that petitioners No.7 to 11 are household ladies. Their presence before the trial court may be exempted. This prayer is not opposed by the learned State counsel.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. In case the petitioners move an application for exemption of their personal appearance, same shall be considered by the trial court in accordance with law. The trial court may exempt the personal appearance of the petitioners on such terms & conditions, as it deems proper to impose. The petitioners may be allowed to appear through their counsel except on the dates their presence is necessary.
