JASPAL SINGH, J.

This is a petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking quashing of FIR No.21, dated 07.05.2014, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib (Annexure P-1) along with all subsequent proceedings arising thereof, on the basis of compromise.

2. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received,

in which, it has been categorically observed that matter in dispute has been compromised amicably between the parties. Even otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest. Compromise is the soul of justice, which not only enhances the social amity, harmony and peace but also reduces friction and discord.

3. So, in view of above circumstances and in view of the pronouncement captioned as **Kulwinder Singh & others v. State of Punjab & others; 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052**, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No.21, dated 07.05.2014, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
