This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for a direction to mark an inquiry to respondent No.2, i.e. CBI, in case FIR No. 39, dated 29.03.2014, registered under Sections 364, 307, 342, 295-A, 506, 120-B, 148 and 149 I.P.C. and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station B Division, Amritsar, apprehending that the matter is not being fairly investigated.

A report has been submitted that out of eight accused persons, namely Manjit Singh Bhola, Mankirat Singh @ Roban, Pargat Singh, Manbir Singh, Sandeep Kumar, Rajinder Kumar Pappu, Amandeep Kumar and Pran Nath, two accused Manjit Singh and Mankirat Singh have been arrested, three accused Rajinder Kumar Pappu, Amandeep Kumar and Pran Nath have been found innocent and proceedings under Sections 82/83 Cr.P.C., initiated against rest of the accused, namely Pargat Singh, Manbir Singh and Sandeep Kumar, are almost complete. Therefore, challan of the instant case against the accused, namely Manjit Singh Bhola, Mankirat Singh, Pargat Singh, Manbir Singh and Sandeep Kumar, has been prepared and is shortly being presented in the learned Court for adjudication.

In view of the reply that challan will be shortly presented before the Court of competent jurisdiction, I do not find any ground to issue any direction for referring the matter to CBI.

It has also been informed that the proceedings under Sections 82/83 Cr.P.C., are being initiated against the persons, who are absconding.

In view of the assurance given in the affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police (Licencing) Amritsar City produced through ASI Satnam Singh, this petition is disposed of at this stage

without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to approach this Court again in case of any complaint of any unfairness.
