The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 19, dated 1.5.2016, registered under Sections 324, 325, 326, 323, 308, 148, 149 of the IPC, at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that it is a cross version case. The petitioner received 2 incised wounds and four other wounds. He has been in custody for more than three months; the victim

has been discharged from hospital and no body has been arrested from

the other side.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab, on instructions from ASI Balkar Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
