The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.136 dated 21.11.2012 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC, Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar, registered at the instance of respondents No.2 alleging that the petitioners had taken money from the private respondents with a false promise for sending them abroad.

After presentation of challan, the parties have entered into compromise. As such quashing of FIR and criminal proceedings have been sought on the basis of compromise.

Parties were directed to appear before the trial Court and record their statements. After recording the statement of the parties, report has been received from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar that the matter has actually been compromised amicably without any threat, coercion or undue influence.

Following the judgment of Full Bench of this Court in **Kulwinder Singh vs. State of Punjab and others 2007(3) RCR(Crl.)1052**, I do not find any reason not to allow the present petition. This petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR along with all criminal proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed, on the basis of compromise.
