Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Mandeep Kaur in case FIR No.83 dated 17.10.2015 for offence punishable under Section 420 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station City-II, Mansa, District Mansa.

On the last date of hearing following order was passed:-

“*Learned Counsel for the petitioner contends that the complainant himself violated the terms and conditions of agreement to sell dated 2.7.2003 and thereafter, he filed suit for permanent injunction in which petitioner filed counter claim. Suit of the complainant was dismissed, whereas, counter claim of petitioner was decreed. Complainant has not filed any suit for specific performance and lodging of FIR on*

17.10.2015 is the evil design of the complainant as he never paid the loan amount to the bank promptly and allowed the amount to swell beyond the limits, which was only Rs.2,00,000/- at the time of agreement to sell.

Notice of motion for 12.01.2016.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail, subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.PC. ”

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Shamsheer Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 24th of November, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
