ANITA CHAUDHRY , J(ORAL)

Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.71 dated 28.07.2015, registered under Section 498-A/406 IPC, Police Station Bareta, Distt. Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the interim order date 28.11.2015, passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has cooperated.

Learned State counsel on instructions from the concerned Investigating Officer has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has pointed out that no steps have been taken by the petitioner to file a petition under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 28.11.2015 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The petitioner is directed to join the complainant in filing the petition under Section 13-B within 15 days.
