The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his sister Jaswinder Kaur, which is stated to be in danger at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6; and also to direct respondents No.3 and 4 not to harass the petitioners at the behest of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied if respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police,
