By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner-Kishan Singh has sought issuance of direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3-State only, at this stage.
3. On the asking of Court, Ms. Harpreet Kaur, AAG, Haryana has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.
4. The sole contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though representation(s) were made way-back in the month of September 2015 by the petitioner for taking action against respondents No. 4 and 5 but till date no action has been taken.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in

case direction is issued to Superintendent of Police, Rewari (Haryana) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-5/T) made in the month of September 2015.

6. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Rewari, Haryana to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation (Annexure P-5/T) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
