Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.158 dated 12.09.2010 registered under Section 13/3/67 of Public Gambling Act, P.S. Rama Mandi, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) as well as order dated 29.07.2013 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Jalandhar (Annexure P-2) vide which petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender along with all subsequent and consequential proceedings arising out of said FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to the order dated 04.02.2016, the petitioner has surrendered before the trial Court and the trial Court has admitted him on bail on furnishing bonds/surety bonds. He further states that though the other co-accused have confessed their guilt and have been fined by the trial Court, however, the petitioner is ready to face the trial.

In view of above, the order dated 04.02.2016 is made absolute.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
