Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as he apprehends danger at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the aforesaid grievance, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 31.08.2016 (Annexure P-8) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Faridkot and the petitioner would be satisfied if the respondent No.2 is directed to look into the contents of said representation.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Jangsher Singh Bhullar, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.
