By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioners have sought issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 to 4 to take an action on the representation made by them against respondents No.5 to 7 for committing fraud with them.

2. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4, only at this stage.
3. At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.
4. At the very outset of arguments, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to decide the representation (Annexure P-12) within a stipulated period.
5. The present petition is disposed of, with the direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar to look into the grievances unfolded by the

petitioners in their representation dated July 28, 2016 (Annexure P-12) and to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
