By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner Meetpal Singh has sought pre-arrest feeling apprehension of his arrest in case FIR No. 165, dated September 17, 2016, under Sections 419, 420, 120-B, 465, 467, 468 & 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Daba, District Ludhiana, during the pendency of trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is ready to appear/surrender before the Jurisdictional Magistrate/Duty Magistrate and further he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to decide his application within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to petitioner to appear/surrender before the Jurisdictional Magistrate/Duty Magistrate within a period of 7 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this

order and move an application seeking bail, in case any application is moved by petitioner after his surrender, the same shall be dealt with and disposed of by learned Jurisdictional Magistrate/Duty Magistrate within a period of 7 days from the date of its filing.
