Main Case

Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.313 dated 16.11.2013, under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474 read with Section 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

Briefly, it may be noticed that the allegations are with regard to having duped the complainant as also nine others of a sum of Rs.61 lacs by issuing fake and forged Canadian Visas.

Even though complainant had alleged entrustment of

money to one Divakar Sharma and Ajay Kumar Jain, during the course of investigation, it has transpired that it is the present petitioner who was working and functioning under the false name of Divakar Sharma.

Allegations against the petitioner are serious in nature.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner makes a submission that he would not be pressing the instant petition seeking benefit of regular bail but prays for directions to be issued to the trial Court for concluding the trial proceedings.

Keeping in view the length of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner and coupled with the fact that the charges in the present case were framed on 19.03.2015, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial and to in any case conclude the same within a period of six months from today.
