Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.101, dated 12.09.2016, under Sections 7(III) of Lottery Regulation Act, 1998, Sections 420/294-A of IPC and Sections 13-A/3/67 of Gambling Act, 1867, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

Vide order dated 17.11.2016, while issuing notice of motion, this Court had ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on ad-interim anticipatory bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Gurjeet Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not needed by the investigating agency.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 17.11.2016 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions prescribed under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
