The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.78 dated 06.11.2014, registered under Sections 307, 427, 379, 506 and 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code; and Sections 25 & 27 of the Arms Act; at P.S. Khem Karan, Distt. Tarn Taran.

Heard.

On 16.11.2016, the following order was passed:-

“Contends that no injury is attributed to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Ms. Harsimrat Rai, DAG, Punjab accepts notice. A complete set of paperbook has been handed over to the learned State counsel, in the Court.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1. That he shall make himself available for

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interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

2. *That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;*
3. *That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.”*

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 16.11.2016, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
