By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, petitioner-Abhishek Sharma @ Shanky has sought issuance of direction to respondents to provide protection to his life and liberty in view of the constant threat/attempts at the hands of his political opponents in view of the ensuing Assembly elections in the State of Punjab.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.
4. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied, in case, direction is given to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the grievances unfolded by

the petitioner in his representation dated 28.10.2016 (Annexure P-3).

The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 28.10.2016 (Annexure P-3) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
