Petitioner, Bhupender has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.539 dated 19.09.2015, registered at Police Station Model Town, Rewari, District Rewari, under Sections 148, 307 and 323 read with Section 149 IPC.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and the complainant also appeared through his counsel. They contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant and have gone

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through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in FIR, but he was not stated to be armed with any specific weapon. No specific injury has been attributed to him. Moreover, learned counsel for the complainant stated that matter has been compromised.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the petitioner to custody. Therefore, finding merit in the present petition, the same is allowed. It is ordered that in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on anticipatory bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
