This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.56 dated 29.5.2015 under sections 22, 61, 85 of N.D.P.S. Act, registered at Police Station, Sadar S.B.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 1000 M.L of intoxicating liquid was effected from the petitioner. As per Chemical Examiner report the liquid was found to be containing codine phosphate. The quantity in excess of 1 kg. of such contraband would be construed as commercial quantity.

The petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other proceedings under the N.D.P.S Act.

Petitioner has been in custody since 29.5.2015. The trial is still stated to be at the initial stage.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, S.B.S. Nagar.

Petition disposed of.
