Affidavit of Shri Raj Kamal Chaudhuri, Secretary, Food Civil Supplies & Consumer Affairs, Punjab along with the Annexures filed in Court is taken on record. A perusal of the same shows that the licence of the ration depot of Shri Balwinder Singh has already been cancelled vide order dated 10.3.2015. Copy of the show cause notice dated 17.9.2015 has also been annexed with the affidavit, showing that departmental action has been initiated against Mr.Nitin Kalia, Inspector Food and Supplies.

In this case, prayer of the petitioner is that for selling controlled wheat in open market, FIR should be lodged against respondent No.4 and for conniving with them, respondent Nos.5 to 13 be also booked.

If the petitioner feels that some criminal offence is made out, it is always open to the petitioner to approach the Illaqa Magistrate and file a criminal complaint against the private respondents.

Petition is accordingly disposed of.
