This is an application under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer for adding Section 379-B IPC in head-note as well as prayer clause in the main petition.

It is mentioned in the application that Section 379-B IPC has been added subsequently and, therefore, the same could not be mentioned in the head-note and prayer clause of the petition. It is prayed that the petitioner may be permitted to place on record amended petition by adding Section 379-B IPC.

Heard.

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In view of grounds mentioned in the application, instant application is allowed. Amended petition is taken on record.

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Allowed as prayed for, subject to all just exceptions. Annexures P-1 and P-2 are taken on record.

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Petitioner, Rachhpal Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No199 dated 30.09.2016, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur, under Sections 379, 323, 379-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner is in custody since 04.10.2016. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to

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his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
