JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners namely Jagpreet Singh and Harjit Singh @ Rinku in case FIR No.62 dated 22.05.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 365, 341, 342, 148, 149, 186, 294, 506 and 323 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Nurpur Bedi.

As per allegations on 21.05.2015 at around 10.30 pm present two petitioners along with three others alleged to have waylaid complainant Kamal Singh and inflicted injuries upon him.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners contend that only three injuries with sticks were found on the person of Kamal Singh which

concededly have been opined to be simple in nature. It is further submitted that a civil dispute is pending between the parties due to which the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case.

It is also stated that as per the MLR of the complainant Kamal Singh he was having an alcoholic smell. The offences are stated to be triable by a magistrate and the petitioners have joined the investigation and cooperated.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Daljit Singh is unable to refute the fact that allegations are of general nature of giving stick blow on the back, belly and legs. He further submits that petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 30th of November, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
