For having been found in possession of 6 grams of heroin and 80 grams of intoxicant powder, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 04.11.2015.

On account of commercial quantity containing diphenoxylate hydrochloride having been recovered from the petitioner, he cannot be granted concession of bail under Section 37 of the NDPS Act.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the trial within a period of six months. In case the trial is not concluded within said period, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of bail.
