For having been found in possession of intoxicating tablets,
the petitioner has been in custody since 07.10.2016.

On the instructions of ASI Sukhwinder Singh, learned State
counsel informs that the report of the chemical examiner, regarding the
contents of the tablets has not yet been received.

On account of said circumstances, the petitioner can be
granted the concession of bail till the receipt of the report of Chemical
Examiner.

In view the above, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is
ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds
to the satisfaction of the trial Court till the receipt of the report of

Chemical Examiner. Petitioner will be required to surrender on receipt of said report without prejudice to his rights to seek concession of regular bail at that stage again.
