Instant petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by Rajwinder Kaur and Chamkaur Singh- petitioners seeking direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect their lives and personal liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 & 5.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioners is that petitioner No.1-Rajwinder Kaur has solemnized marriage with petitioner No.2-Chamkaur Singh against the wishes and consent of her parents. Since the parents of petitioner No.1-Rajwinder Kaur were against their lives and liberty, they were constrained to file instant petition.

3. At this juncture, it has been pointed out by learned State counsel that after issuance of notice of motion in this case, the police approached petitioner No.1-Rajwinder Kaur. She has suffered the statement that at present, there is no apprehension to their lives and liberty at the instance of respondents No.4 & 5 and she does not require protection any more as her parents have already agreed/consented to her marriage with petitioner No.2-Chamkaur Singh. She further stated that she is living happily in the family of her in-laws.

4. In view of the aforesaid aspects of the case, instant petition has rendered infructuous and same is dismissed as such.
