This order shall dispose of CRM Nos. M-40244 of 2015 and CRM No. M-43231 of 2015 as both these petitions have been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.155 dated 10.09.2015, under Sections 420/120-B of Indian Penal Code and Section 7 of Essential Commodities Act 1955 and 29 of Insecticide Act, 1968, registered at Police Station City Kotkapura, District Faridkot.

On 30.11.2015 while issuing notice of motion in CRM No. M-40244 of 2015, this Court had granted interim protection subject to the petitioner joining investigation. Likewise on 21.12.2015, similar

order was passed in CRM No. M-43231 of 2015.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jagdish Singh would submit that the petitioners in both these connected petitions have since joined investigation. It has also been fairly stated that the petitioners are not required for any custodial interrogation and there is no recovery to be effected from them.

Accordingly, both the petitions are allowed. Orders dated 30.11.2015 in CRM No.M-40244 of 2015 and dated 21.12.2015 in CRM No. M-43231 of 2015 are made absolute.

Petitions stand disposed of.
