During course of arguments, it has been informed that investigation of this case has been entrusted to Sanmeet Kaur, Assistant Inspector General of Police for completion of the investigation.

Sanmeet Kaur, I.P.S present in the Court informs that the investigation is being now conducted in her supervision and that the relevant documents necessary for the fair investigation have already been recovered.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for respondent No.2 as well as investigating officer, I am of the opinion that there has not been any violation of order dated 30.09.2015 and that respondent No.2 has also not misused concession of bail granted to her.

Application for cancellation of bail is dismissed. However, it is observed that in case any document is required by the investigating agency as per any direction passed by this Court earlier, a written notice will be issued to respondent No.2 Baljit Kaur for production of the documents.
