The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.710 dated 22.10.2014, registered under Sections 365 IPC, Police Station Nuh, District Mewat.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 04.11.2014 and an application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. had been filed and the trial is taking time.

The copy of the statement made by the complainant has been made available, which shows that the victim was just 17 years old and the petitioner is her uncle (Foofa) in relation. Allegations have been levelled under Sections 365, 376-D IPC.

Considering the above, I am not inclined to grant bail.

However, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and complete within five months from the next date of hearing, which is stated to be 16.08.2016.
