Crl. Misc. No. M-40281 of 2016

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 98 dated 08.10.2015 registered at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC.

The parties were sent for mediation, which had failed.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the gold articles were not recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had pointed out that they had given a list (Annexure P-4 and P-5) to show the articles which have been returned. He states that they are also ready to deposit Rs. 50,000/- in lieu of the articles which the complainant side is demanding.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 30.11.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will deposit Rs.50,000/- with the trial Court. The deposit shall be made within 15 days and the complainant would be entitled to withdraw the same. The petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
