The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 25 dated 14.02.2016, registered under Sections 304-B, 120-B IPC, Police Station Balachaur, District SBS Nagar (Nawanshahar).

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is disabled and is almost blind and she was not at home that night and she had gone to attend the Bhog ceremony of a relation of her daughter from her husband side.

The counsel for the petitioner also states that the family was immediately informed and the FSL report states that there is no poison and the girl had firstly been taken to a RMP and then to a hospital by the husband and the petitioner's son has been arrested.

The State counsel says that the Medical Officer had stated that the girl was brought to the hospital at 11:00 PM and she died a little after 1:00 AM and her blood pressure was un-recordable.

The deceased had been married to the son of the petitioner in December, 2014. The death has taken place within one year and two months of the marriage. It was a unnatural death. The parents were informed only at 12:45 AM. The incident had occurred at around 10:00 PM. The petitioner has not disclosed in which hospital the girl was taken initially. The admission in the second hospital was at 11:00 PM. The allegations are serious. No case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
