Petitioner – Gram Panchayat, Village Chunni Kalan, Tehsil Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib through its Sarpanch Balbir Singh has filed the present petition under Section 482 CrPC for issuance of directions to respondents no.4 and 5 not to harass and humiliate the members of the Gram Panchayat

Reply by way of affidavit of Satinderpal Singh, PPS, DSP, Circle Bassi Pathana, District Fatehgarh Sahib, on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3, has already been filed, whereby the allegations levelled against respondents no.4 and 5 have been denied. It has been submitted that neither

any application was filed by anybody before the concerned police authorities against the petitioner nor any application was ever filed by the petitioner against any person and the respondents no.4 and 5 have unnecessarily been dragged into the litigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh, submits that the police is neither harassing the petitioner nor the petitioner has made any such complaint to the police, as alleged.

In view of the categorical stand of the respondent-State, no further order is called for in the present petition, as the petitioner has approached this Court without making any representation to the police authorities.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
