This is the second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of interim bail to the petitioner from 18th November to 28th November, 2016 in case FIR No.757 dated 04.09.2015, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar for attending the marriage of his nephew.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the main application for regular bail is fixed for 23.11.2016 and in case the petitioner is granted interim bail he would surrender back on 22.11.2016 in the evening.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that he would have no objection but the Court granting bail be directed to ensure adequate surety/security to ensure that the petitioner does not jump bail.

Learned Deputy Advocate General has also very fairly stated that he would have no objection to this limited prayer being granted.

In the circumstances let the petitioner be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the CJM/Duty Magistrate, Hisar with the stipulation suggested by the counsel for the complainant.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
