The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C seeking the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.372 dated 23.10.2015 under sections 420, 464, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B I.P.C, registered at Police Station, Civil Lines, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner would vehemently contend that the allegations are targeted against Harpreet Singh and with respect to the registry of a residential house being in his possession unauthorizedly. It is further contended that the dispute essentially is civil in nature being a money transaction and involves members of the same family.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner at length, this Court is not inclined to grant to the petitioner the concession of pre-arrest bail.

The complainant Kulwant Kaur is none other than the mother of the petitioner. Perusal of the F.I.R would reveal that there are specific allegations against the present petitioner with regard to having withdrawn a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- from the father's account by misusing documents of the petitioner and even opening a bank account in her name.

Further allegations that the registry of the residential house has been given to a third person without due authorization.

In view of such allegations, it would be a case where custodial interrogation of the petitioner may well be necessary.

Petition, accordingly, is dismissed.
