**Kuldip Singh, J.** (Oral):

The petitioner is seeking his transfer from District Jail, Sirsa to Model Jail, Faridkot. It comes out that the petitioner was convicted and sentenced under the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Sirsa. He was also convicted and sentenced under Section 302 IPC by a Punjab court. The petitioner is presently confined in Sirsa Jail.

I am of the view that if the petitioner is seeking his transfer from Sirsa jail to Punjab on one or the other grounds, he should in the first instance move the appropriate authority for his transfer from Haryana to Punjab. If such application is moved, the same shall be decided expeditiously and preferably within two months.

The petition is disposed of.
