Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

The petition is for quashing of FIR No.35 dated 9.7.2011, registered under Sections 323, 452, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga, along with all consequential proceedings.

Report of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Nihal Singh Wala received. Learned Magistrate has recorded the statements of the complainant as well as the accused and has reported that the parties have effected compromise, which is genuine and voluntary and not result of coercion or undue influence.

Statements of the parties have also been appended with the report.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably settled the dispute, FIR No.35 dated 9.7.2011, registered under Sections 323, 452, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Badhni Kalan, District Moga, along with all consequential proceedings stands quashed.

The petition is accordingly allowed.
