KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

The prayer in the present case is for issuance of directions to the respondents to register FIR in view of authority of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Lalita Kumari Versus Government of U.P. and others, (2014) 2 SCC 1, on the basis of complaint dated 20.9.2014 (Annexure-P-2) and subsequent reminders.

The learned proxy counsel appearing for the learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had filed a complaint dated 20.9.2014 (Annexure-P-2) to the police, but the police has not registered the FIR on the ground that after the inquiry, it was found that it was a civil dispute.

In these circumstances, the petitioner is relegated to avail remedy by filing a criminal complaint alongwith application under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. before the concerned Illaqa Magistrate and seek appropriate remedy.
