On the instructions of ASI Balwinder Singh, learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has already joined investigation.

Even otherwise, perusal of the police file indicates that offences under Sections 382, 342, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC have been deleted. All the subsisting offences are bailable except for offence under Section 506 IPC.

The petitioner has joined the investigation. It does not appear to be a case of custodial interrogation.

Petition is allowed. Interim order dated 01.12.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
