Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8(wrongly mentioned as respondents No. 4 to 9).

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI-Ramesh Chand, submits that the statements of private respondents No. 4 to 8 have been recorded, wherein, they stated that they will not cause any type of harm or threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners.

Photocopies of statements of respondents No. 4 to 8 produced in Court today, are taken on record.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the statements furnished by private respondents No. 4 to 8, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of. However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach concerned SSP, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
