This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.98 dated 07.07.2016 under Sections 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

The marriage of the petitioner has solemnized on 16.01.2016 and he left for Canada on 19.02.2016. After the petitioner went to Canada, the complainant/respondent No.2 had gone to her parental home. She did not facilitate the petitioner in the process of procuring spouse Visa. Thereafter, on a complaint made by the respondent/complainant the present FIR has been registered.

Petitioner is seeking quashing of the FIR on the ground that no case of harassment is made out. He has further informed the Court that no other proceedings pending between the parties and during investigation, other family members have been found to be innocent.

Keeping in view that the marriage of the petitioner has
