Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered at the instance of Varinder Kumar alleging that on 11.09.2016 the petitioner along with others had gone inside the house of the complainant. The petitioner allegedly kept a knife on the neck of the complainant and his co-accused Paramjit Singh @ Sandeep Singh searched the house and robbed the complainant of a sum of Rs.20,000/- from the locker of the almirah.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that on account of dispute of the complainant with his maid Paramjit Kaur, the said maid and other relations of Paramjit Kaur have been arrayed as accused.

The petitioner has joined the investigation. Three accused in the same FIR, have been granted concession of regular bail. This case does not appear to be a case of custodial interrogation.

The petition is allowed. Interim order dated 18.11.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
