Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

At this stage, Mr. Kulwant Singh, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of private respondents No. 4 and 5 and filed Power of Attorney, which is taken on record. He submits that statements of private respondents No. 4 and 5 has already been recorded and as per their statements, there is no threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners from them.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI-Sushil Kumar, submits that both the petitioners have made statements wherein it was stated that they do not have any threat to their life and liberty from the other side.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition and same is accordingly disposed of. However, in case the petitioners still apprehend any threat to their life and liberty, they are at liberty to approach concerned SSP, who shall take necessary steps for redressal of their grievance in accordance with law.
