JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 122, dated December 19, 2014, under Sections 323, 324, 34 of IPC (Section 325 IPC added lateron vide DDR No. 32, dated December 31, 2014), registered at Police Station Boha, District Mansa (**Annexure P-1 & P-2**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise (**Annexure P-3**).

2. In compliance of order dated March 03, 2016, statement of the parties have been recorded by the trial Court. Report of

learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Budhlada, has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that the matter has been compromised between the parties with the intervention of the relatives and respectable persons and with their free will or without any pressure from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 122, dated December 19, 2014, under Sections 323, 324, 34 of IPC (Section 325 IPC added lateron vide DDR No. 32, dated December 31, 2014), registered at Police Station Boha, District Mansa (**Annexure P-1 & P-2**) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioners.
