This order shall dispose of two petitions for grant of regularo
bail filed by two accused persons in cross version cases i.e. filed under
Sections 302, 452, 325, 324, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 302 IPC added

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later) and under Sections 323, 324, 325, 148, 149 and 307 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later), in case FIR No.47 dated 31.03.2015, registered at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Petitioner Gurlal Singh is the main accused for having caused death and he has been in custody since 29.03.2015 while petitioner Baljit Singh Bali is the main accused of committing attempt to murder and he has been in custody since 26.05.2016.

Both the parties have stated that they would have no objection if the bail application of the other side is allowed.

Learned State counsel is also not in a position to deny the bail applications.

Keeping in view the period of custody of both the accused persons vis-a-vis, gravity of the charges against them and the fact that the trial/trials is not to be concluded in the near future, it would not be appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to both of them.

In these circumstances, both the petitioners are directed to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Both the petitions stand allowed accordingly.
