By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for brevity, "Code" only), Rajpal-petitioner has sought bail in case FIR No. 220, dated 26.06.2016, under Section 379-B IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Beri, District Jhajjar.

2. Undisputably, petitioner was arrested in this case on July 26, 2016 and since then he is cooling his heels behind the bars. On conclusion of investigation, report under Section 173(2) of the Code has already been presented. The disposal of the trial would take sufficient long time.

3. Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspects but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and

petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, during pendency of trial, at the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
