INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioners, Jasbir Singh and Balveer Singh have filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.111 dated 24.09.2016, registered at Police Station Chabbewal, Hoshiarpur, under Sections 395, 365 and 342 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of complainant-Balwinder Kumar. There is allegation that on 23.09.2016, when the complainant and Sham Babu were present at shop, accused persons came there and one of them took out pistol from his dub and threatened the complainant not to raise alarm. Out of

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them, three young persons caught the complainant and roped him with the chair and sprinkled some spray in his eyes. When the complainant made an attempt to release himself, a person having pistol hit its *butt* to him. Thereafter, all the five persons took off four gold rings, one gold chain and bracelet worn by the the complainant. They also snatched a sum of ₹20,000/- from the pocket of the complainant.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioners are required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioners are entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
