Petitioner, Kuldeep Singh @ Kuldip Singh has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.59 dated 07.05.2016, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar, under Section 379-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the statement of Chirag Kapur. As per the allegations in FIR, on 06.05.2016, complainant had gone to Amritsar in connection with his business in his car. At about 10.00/10.15 P.M, he left for Ludhiana from Amritsar on the said car. At about 11.30/12.00 mid-night, when he reached near CRPF camp behind Vidhipur, then one Innova car bearing registration

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No.PB-08-AF-7654, grey in colour, came from the back side and intercepted him. Out of the said Innova Car, 4-5 unknown persons came out and out of them, four persons were Sikh gentlemen. Two Sikh gentlemen were carrying pistols in their hands and on gun point, they took the complainant out of his car and snatched his car, mobile phone make Samsung S7 Edge, Laptop make HP and passport of his some clients lying in the car. Those persons left their Innova vehicle at the spot and fled away in the car of the complainant.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that the petitioner is required for custodial interrogation, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled for the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
