It has been informed that despite repeated directions, the petitioner has not joined investigation. Regarding status of trial, it has been informed that challan has been presented against the co-accused of the petitioner and petitioner having neither joined investigation nor having appeared before the Investigating Officer, he was not challaned along with other co-accused.

I have heard counsel for the petitioner, State counsel as well as the counsel for the complainant and gone through the record. The petitioner has been able to secure the interim relief by making statement before this Court that he would pay the entire amount due to the complainant. Even a direction was passed by a Coordinate Bench on 30.4.2015 to pay the entire amount to the complainant.

Petitioner has not complied with the interim direction nor has joined investigation or discharged his liability,

In view of said circumstances, this petition is dismissed. However, nothing said in this order or any direction given in this case will be taken as an admission of liability by the petitioner in any proceedings. Interim orders earlier passed are hereby vacated.
