Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner and her family members who are being constantly threatened by respondents No.6 to 19 to withdraw the case in FIR No.506 dated 11.09.2016 under Section 148, 149, 323, 506 IPC registered against accused/respondents No.13 to 19.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the aforesaid relief, petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 12.09.2016 (Annexure P-7) to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Rohtak, District Rohtak and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to look into the contents of said representation and pass appropriate order in accordance with law.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 5 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Arun Kumar, AAG, Haryana,
accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting on the claim as projected in the representation dated 12.09.2016 (Annexure P-7), present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take note of contents of said representation and to act in accordance with law.

However, it is made clear that in case the claim of the petitioner as projected in the representation dated 12.09.2016 (Annexure P-7), is found false, respondent No.2 shall be at liberty to initiate action against her.
